

TERMS & CONDITIONS

WIN! A meet and greet at the Sydney Premier of Puss In Boots

1. Instructions on 'how to enter' and prizes form part of conditions of entry. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these conditions of entry.
2. Entry is open to Australian residents who are able to redeem the prize at the time, date and venue stipulated by the Promoters (currently scheduled to occur in Sydney on Sunday November 27, 2011). If you are under the age of 18 years, your parent or legal guardian must enter on your behalf, and accompany you to the concert on the dates specified below. Employees of the Promoter, and their immediate families and agencies associated with this promotion are ineligible to enter.
